Christian Koinonia's Common Denominator:

Gal 3:26-29

²⁶ So **in Christ Jesus** you are all children of God through faith, ²⁷ for all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. ²⁸ There is neither Jew nor Gentile, neither slave nor free, nor is there male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus. ²⁹ If you belong to Christ, then you are... heirs according to the promise.

4 CHRISTIAN KOINONIA COMMITMENTS (IN REGARDS TO RELATIONAL CARE)...

1. CHRISTIAN KOINONIA (FELLOWSHIP / COMMUNITY) REQUIRES AUTHENTICITY.

1 Thess 2:8 ...we were delighted to share with you not only the gospel of God <u>but our lives as well</u>. (NIV) **1 John 1:7**... if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, **we have fellowship** with one another... (NIV)

2. CHRISTIAN KOINONIA (FELLOWSHIP / COMMUNITY) REQUIRES <u>MUTUALITY</u>.

"The way God designed our bodies is a model for understanding our lives together as a church: every part dependent on every other part" (1 Cor 12:25—Message Paraphrase).

The Bible commands mutual accountability, mutual encouragement, mutual serving and mutual honoring.

Rom 1:12 [may we] be mutually encouraged by each other's faith, both yours and mine. (ESV)

Rom 12:10 Love one another with brotherly affection. Outdo one another in showing honor (ESV)

Rom 14:19 pursue...mutual upbuilding. (ESV)

Phil 2:3 ... count others more significant than yourselves. 4 Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others. (ESV)

3. CHRISTIAN KOINONIA (FELLOWSHIP / COMMUNITY) REQUIRES COMPASSION.

Matt 9:36; 14:14; Mark 6:34. When he saw the crowds, he had compassion for them, because they were

...., like sheep without a shepherd. (ESV)

Gal 6:2 Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ. (NIV) **Col 3:12, 13** Put on then, as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, compassionate hearts...bearing with one another...(ESV)

2 Cor 5:14 "For Christ's love compels us..." (NIV)

4. CHRISTIAN KOINONIA (FELLOWSHIP / COMMUNITY) REQUIRES MERCY, FORGIVNESS & GRACE.

Colossians 3:13 You must make allowances for each other's faults and forgive the person who offends you.

Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others. (NLT)

Discussion & Reflection Questions:

- 1. Koinonia is used nineteen times in the New Testament and in addition to being translated as "fellowship" it is also translated by the words, "contribution," "sharing," and "participation." A close study of the usage of this word shows that action is always included in its meaning. Fellowship, you see, is not just being-together, it is doing-together, because we share something specific in common...together. Why is it so important for us to understand and maintain the centrality of Christ Jesus as the source of our Koinonia? Think back to Galatians 3:26-29 & 1 Corinthians 12:4-26
- 2. Reread John 13:34,35. Put in into your own words. What is the actual command? Why do you think it was to Jesus to draw this connection?
- 3. We looked at four (of many) *necessary commitments* in order to foster God-honoring **fellowship** and **community** (Koinonia). Which of the four comes easily for you to practice? Which of the four is more difficult for you to practice? What are other essential markers / commitments necessary to foster Christ-like "togetherness"?
