# Week #1: Designed for Relationship - 1 Corinthians 12:4-11

- A. God equips His people to influence others (vv. 4-7)
  - 1. The gifts come from the Spirit (vs. 4)
  - 2. The people & places to use them come from the Lord Jesus (vs. 5)
  - 3. The influence for good comes from the Father (vs. 6)
  - 4. Don't miss the Trinity!
  - 5. The Spirit is thus revealed and others profited (vs. 7)
- B. Examples of some of the gifts the Spirit distributes (vv. 8-10)
- C. The Spirit oversees the entire process (vs. 11)

### Week #2: United but Diverse - 1 Corinthians 12:12-20

The Spirit immerses each believer into Christ and unites us to one another (vv. 12-13)

- 1. All believes belong to the body of Christ (vs. 12)
- 2. All believers share a common immersion and are indwelt by the same Spirit (vs. 13)

Spirit Baptism provides for our:

- 1. Freedom / Life (Romans 6:4)
- 2. Unification (Ephesians 4:4)

Having been united, each believer functions distinctly within the whole (vv. 14-20)

- 1. The church is diverse (vs. 14)
- 2. The needs of the church demand diversity of gifting (vv. 15-17)
- 3. In fact, diversity is part of God's design and is essential to the church's function (vv. 18-20)

Week #3: Koinonia	
Koinonia:	
Christian Koinonia Common Denominator:	

Christian Koinonia (Fellowship / Community) Requires 4 Commitments for relational care:

- 1. Authenticity (1 Thess. 2:8; 1 John 1:7)
- 2. Mutuality (Romans 1:12; 12:10; 14:19; Phil. 2:3)
- 3. Compassion Matt. 9:36; 14:14; Mark 6:34; Gal. 6:2; 2 Cor. 5:14)
- 4. Mercy, Forgiveness, & Grace (Colossians 3:13)

#### Week #4: Designed to Care for One Another - Colossians 3:12-17

Active, heartfelt love guarantees harmonious living together with God's people (vs.14) Four actions guarantee we are truly loving God's people:

- 1. Forbearing and forgiving as Christ has done for us (vs. 12)

  Compassion / Kindness / Humility / Meekness / Patience
- 2. Pursuing peaceful living with one another (vs. 15)
- 3. Filling yourself with God's Word and speaking it to one another (vs. 16)
- 4. Revealing Jesus in everything you do (vs. 17)

# Week #5: Designed to Grow Together - Ephesians 4:11-16

God designed us to grow!

Equip / Building up / Attain / Mature / Measure of stature / Grow

How our growth plays out:

- 1. We are united around the truth of Jesus (vv. 11-13)
- 2. We mature into the likeness of Jesus (vs. 13)
- 3. We stand firm in the wisdom of Jesus (vs. 14)

#### How God's design works:

- 1. The design works because of its connection to Christ (vs. 15)
- 2. The design works because the whole body is in union (vs. 16)
- 3. The design works because each individual keeps the body united (vs. 16)
- 4. The design works because each individual aids in the body's growth (vs. 16)

# Week #6: Suffer and Comfort Together - 2 Corinthians 1:3-11

3 Foundational Truths

- 1. We anticipate suffering while in a relationship with God (vv. 3-5, 7)
  - a. God is sovereign over all suffering (Isaiah 40:1)
  - b. God is familiar with all suffering
  - c. God is the source of all compassion
  - d. God is sufficient for all comfort (Psalm 9:9-10)
- 2. We act as conduits of comfort for God (vv. 4-7, 11)
  - a. So that suffering and comfort become communally beneficial (2 Cor. 7:5-7)
  - b. So that we might care for each other's hurts & carry one another's burdens (Gal. 6:2)
  - c. So that we grow in willingness to share the fruit of both pain & comfort (1 Cor. 12:26)
- 3. We anchor ourselves to the power and promises of God (vv. 8-11)
  - a. God is our victory
  - b. God is our deliverer (Psalm 34:18)
  - c. God is our hope (Psalm 121:1-2)
