Introduction: lies that can plague us.

Promises we trust about personal temptation.

1. Promise #1: He limits our personal temptations to our abilities.

 $\underline{1\text{Cor. }10:13}$ No temptation has overtaken you that is not common to man. God is faithful, and he will not let you be tempted beyond your ability, but with the temptation he will also provide the way of escape, that you may be able to endure it.

2. Promise #2: He produces "good" from all situations.

Rom. 8:28 And we know that for those who love God all things work together for good, for those who are called according to his purpose.

Promises we trust about church family relationships.

1. Promise #1: He equips us to help others.

1Cor. 12:4 Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit;

1Cor. 12:5 and there are varieties of service, but the same Lord;

 $\underline{1Cor.\ 12:6}\ and\ there\ are\ varieties\ of\ activities,\ but\ it\ is\ the\ same\ God\ who\ empowers\ them\ all\ in\ everyone.$

1Cor. 12:7 To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good.

2. Promise #2: He enables us to unite & care for His people.

1Cor. 12:25 that there may be no division in the body, but that the members may have the same care for one another.

1Cor. 12:26 If one member suffers, all suffer together; if one member is honored, all rejoice together.

 - b. What benefits can you envision as you invest in your understanding and use of these verses? How might they change you?
 - c. Recall, reflect and record moments when God has produced "good" through hard times you've experienced.
- 4. Explain the **three primary promises** of 1 Corinthians 12:4, 5 & 6. How do these truths help **develop confidence** in God using you to build up the church body?
- 5. How do unity ("no division") and mutual care influence each other in 1 Corinthians 12:25-26?
