Church Leadership Titus 1:5-9

Paul's Intent: To direct Titus in correctly ordering the newly planted churches in Crete.

Titus 1:5a This is why I left you in Crete, so that you might put what remained into order.

Paul's Priority: To direct Titus to establish qualified & functional leadership.

1. There's a bunch of them.

Titus 1:5 *This is why I left you in Crete, so that you might put what* remained into order, and appoint elders in every town as I directed you—

Acts 14:21 When they had preached the gospel to that city and had made many disciples, they returned to Lystra and to Iconium and to *Antioch*, ²² *strengthening the souls of the disciples, encouraging them to* continue in the faith, and saying that through many tribulations we must enter the kingdom of God. ²³ And when they had appointed elders for them in every church, with prayer and fasting they committed them to the Lord in whom they had believed.

Paul's Pattern:

- 1. Lead people to Christ.
- 2. Nurture them in the faith.
- 3. Establish them in endurance of eternal hope.
- 4. Provide them with loving, spiritual leaders.





2. They're appointed by other elders.

3. They have multiple names/titles.

4. They can't have "ugly" issues in life.

He must not be arrogant or quick-tempered or a drunkard or violent or greedy for gain,

5. Their family must be functioning properly.

Titus 1:6 if anyone is above reproach, the husband of one wife, and his children are believers and not open to the charge of debauchery or insubordination.

6. They can't be characterized by . . .

Titus 1:7 For an overseer, as God's steward, must be above reproach. He must not be arrogant or quick-tempered or a drunkard or violent or greedy for gain,

7. They must be characterized by . . .

Titus 1:8 but hospitable, a lover of good, self-controlled, upright, holy, and disciplined.

8. They must be firmly committed to God's Word & able to use it.

Titus 1:9 He must hold firm to the trustworthy word as taught, so that he may be able to give instruction in sound doctrine and also to rebuke those who contradict it.

What does leadership look like among Jesus' people?

Heb. 13:7 Remember your leaders, those who spoke to you the word of God. Consider the outcome of their way of life, and imitate their faith...

17 Obey your leaders and submit to them, for they are keeping watch over your souls, as those who will have to give an account. Let them do this with joy and not with groaning, for that would be of no advantage to you
