MESSAGE NOTES

Condemned in Adam – Justified in Christ Romans 5:15-21

Through Adam sin and death entered the world.

Rom. 5:12 Therefore, just as sin came into the world through one man, and death through sin. and so death spread to all men because all sinned—

Distinctions between Christ and Adam

Jesus is the remedy for the condemnation and death resulting in Adam's sin.

Rom. 5:15 But the free gift **is not like** the trespass. For if many died through one man's trespass, much more have the grace of God and the free gift by the grace of that one man Jesus Christ abounded for many.

Adam's singular trespass brought condemnation to all mankind; God's grace overcomes a multitude of sins.

Rom. 5:16 And the free gift **is not like** the result of that one man's sin. For the judgment following one trespass brought condemnation, but the free gift following many trespasses brought justification.

In Adam all die, through faith-righteousness God's grace gives life.

Rom. 5:17 For if, because of one man's trespass, death reigned through that one man, much more will those who receive the abundance of grace and the free gift of righteousness reign in life through the one man Jesus Christ.

Similarities between Christ and Adam

Adam's one act brings condemnation; Jesus one act leads to justification.

Rom. 5:18 Therefore, as one trespass led to condemnation for all men, so one act of righteousness leads to justification and life for all men.

Adam's one act of disobedience ushers in death; Jesus one act of obedience makes life possible.

Rom. 5:19 For as by the one man's disobedience the many were made sinners, so by the one man's obedience the many will be made righteous.

Phil 2:8 And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

The triumph of grace over law and sin

The law came with the purpose of showing the overwhelming need for grace.

Rom. 5:20-21 Now the law came in to increase the trespass, but where sin increased, grace abounded all the more, **21** so that, as sin reigned in death, grace also might reign through righteousness leading to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

To summarize: Through Adam's sin condemnation and death entered the world and all men in Adam are condemned as sinners. However, God in his grace, through Christ's righteousness justifies all who are in Christ.
