MESSAGE NOTES

The Steadfast, Unshakable Love of God Romans 8:31-39

Rom. 8:31 What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?

God's great love, demonstrated by the gift of salvation through His son, enables us to endure opposition.

Rom. 8:31-34 What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? ³² He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things? ³³ Who shall bring any charge against God's elect? It is God who justifies. ³⁴ Who is to condemn? Christ Jesus is the one who died—more than that, who was raised—who is at the right hand of God, who indeed is interceding for us.

Questions without answers

- (1) "What then shall we say to these things?" (8:31a)
- (2) "If God is for us, who is against us?" (8:31b)
- (3) "He who did not spare His own Son, but gave Him over for us all, how will He not also with Him freely give us all things?" (8:32)
- (4) "Who will bring a charge against God's elect?" (8:33a)
- (5) "God is the one who justifies; who is the one who condemns?" (8:33b-34a)



God's great love for us in Christ Jesus enables us to be more than conquerors through every trial for His sake.

Rom. 8:35-37 Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or danger, or sword? ³⁶ As it is written, "For your sake we are being killed all the day long; we are regarded as sheep to be slaughtered." ³⁷ No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us.

Another question without an answer:

(6) "Who will separate us from the love of Christ?" (8:35a)

God's great love for Paul strengthened him to bear all the trials, tribulations and persecution he faced as the cost of discipleship.

2 Cor. 11:23-27 Are they servants of Christ? I am a better one—I am talking like a madman—with far greater labors, far more imprisonments, with countless beatings, and often near death. ²⁴ Five times I received at the hands of the Jews the forty lashes less one. ²⁵ Three times I was beaten with rods. Once I was stoned. Three times I was shipwrecked; a night and a day I was adrift at sea; ²⁶ on frequent journeys, in danger from rivers, danger from robbers, danger from my own people, danger from Gentiles, danger in the city, danger in the wilderness, danger at sea, danger from false brothers; ²⁷ in toil and hardship, through many a sleepless night, in hunger and thirst, often without food, in cold and exposure.

God's great love for us gives us confidence for life now and the assurance of life in eternity.
