1. A pattern of love already existed (9-10a).

You are serving the Lord Christ.
 - **25** For the wrongdoer will be paid back for the wrong he has done, and there is no partiality.
 - **4:1** Masters, treat your bondservants justly and fairly, knowing that you also have a Master in heaven.
