MESSAGE NOTES

The kind of church that keeps spawning godliness!

Titus 2:1-10

Looking back at chapter 1:

- 1. "... put what remained into order" (5a).
- 2. "... appoint elders in every town" (5b).
- 3. "... what they ought not to teach" (11b).

How relationships of godliness develop among Jesus' people:

1. We must grasp the reasons for developing godliness.

a. Three explanations lie in the passage itself.

Titus 2:5 ... that the word of God may not be reviled.

Titus 2:8... so that an opponent may be put to shame,

Titus 2:10... so that in everything they may adorn the doctrine of God our Savior.





b. The next paragraph gives an expanded explanation (2:11-15).

Titus 2:11 For the grace of God has appeared, bringing salvation for all people, ¹² training us to renounce ungodliness and worldly passions, and to live self-controlled, upright, and godly lives in the present age, ¹³ waiting for our blessed hope, the appearing of the glory of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, ¹⁴ who gave himself for us to redeem us from all lawlessness and to purify for himself a people for his own possession who are zealous for good works.

c. Does not Romans 6-8 also give greatly expanded reasons?

Rom. 8:2 For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death.

Rom. 8:29 ... to be conformed to the image of his Son, ...

2. Paul categorizes believers by role, gender, & age.

a. To leaders:

Titus 2:1 But as for you, teach what accords with sound doctrine....⁷ Show yourself in all respects to be a model of good works, and in your teaching show integrity, dignity, 8 and sound speech that cannot be condemned, so that an opponent may be put to shame, having nothing evil to say about us.

b. To men older than most:

Titus 2:2 Older men are to be sober-minded, dignified, self-controlled, sound in faith, in love, and in steadfastness.

c. To women older than most:

Titus 2:3 Older women likewise are to be reverent in behavior, not slanderers or slaves to much wine. They are to teach what is good, ⁴ and so train the young women ...

d. To women younger than most:

Titus 2:3 Older women likewise are to be reverent in behavior, not slanderers or slaves to much wine. They are to teach what is good, ⁴ and so train the young women to love their husbands and children, ⁵ to be self-controlled, pure, working at home, kind, and submissive to their own husbands, that the word of God may not be reviled.

e. To men younger than most:

Titus 2:6 Likewise, urge the younger men to be self-controlled.

f. To believers poorer & "lower" than most:

Titus 2:9 Bondservants are to be submissive to their own masters in everything; they are to be well-pleasing, not argumentative, ¹⁰ not pilfering, but showing all good faith, so that in everything they may adorn the doctrine of God our Savior.

Multiple ways in which God cares for His people:

- 1. The individual members of the Trinity indwelling us.
- 2. Elders of Jesus' church teaching the Word & "keeping watch over your souls."
- 3. People with the spiritual gift of shepherding.
- 4. Mature believers of the same gender teaching us on the "how's" of godliness.
- 5. Believers of the opposite gender relating to us as family.
- 6. Every "random" believer speaking the truth in love so as to build us up.
- 7. Our biological & adoptive families influencing us to develop assumptions.
